

## Project: Hwy 1 R.W. Bruhn Bridge and Approaches Project Notice of Work

Date of Issue: January 6, 2025

### **Blasting Activity January 7, 2025 – June 15, 2025:**

The R.W. Bruhn Bridge Construction Project will be starting blasting works on January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The blasting work will continue until June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025 during 9:00am-3:00pm. It is anticipated blasting will occur daily Monday-Saturday, and may be multiple blasts per day. Blasting will be limited to the area seen in **Figure 1** below. Entry points to this area will be blocked off for access during blasting. We ask all residents to thoroughly read the safety protocol below and notify our team for any questions regarding blasting work.

### **Safety Protocol:**

An air horn warning signal will be given prior to blasting then the control zone will be swept to ensure area is clear before each blast. Each blast will take place **2 minutes after** the sound of **12 short blasts** from an air horn. After the blast, when the control zone is all clear, a **5 second** air horn blast will occur.
